## Details

- 1. Formatting: use a two-column paper format, e.g. IEEE or ACM; use Latex or Word, to take advantage of the template provided to you on the IEEE or ACM websites
- 2. On at most two pages, provide the following information about your project
  - a. Title
  - b. Abstract
  - c. Introduction: problem, problem importance, shortcoming of existing (other) approaches, proposed approach
  - d. Method details: input, how the input is processed, output, output quality metrics
  - e. Midway milestones: what you will have working by approximately April 10-15
  - f. Completion criteria: what you will demonstrate by the final project presentation, approximately the last week of classes
- 3. Build a five slide presentation of your project, which you will be using in class on Tuesday March 27<sup>th</sup> for your project proposal presentation.
