- 1. Problem Statement: 0.5 points
- 2. Background: Explain background information about the problem, as well as the domain and targeted users. Mention whether there are any applications that are similar to your planned work. Discuss the limitations of the other solutions and how you address each limitation. (1 point)
- 3. Requirements: 3.5 points
 - a. The requirements should be divided into two sections (Functional Requirements and Non-functional Requirements).
 - b. Requirements must be distributed as evenly as possible amongst the team.
 - c. Make sure the requirements contain enough work to be done that each team member will have to spend around 10 hours/week for the project.
 - d. If point c is not met, points will be deducted and the team will be asked to resubmit the backlog with an adequate amount of work.
 - e. Please be thorough, this will help when you develop your test plan.

Note: All assignments should include team number, member names, and a project title on the front page.
